Six Municipalities Cited for Outstanding Recycling Achievements in 2021

Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority Recognizes Six
Lebanon County Municipalities for Outstanding Recycling
Achievements During 2021

Lebanon, September 13, 2022: On Tuesday, September 13, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. at the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority's regular monthly board meeting held in conjunction with the Electronics Recycling Facility Dedication at 1805 Russell Road, Lebanon, six (6) municipalities were presented a recycling award for outstanding achievements in 2021. West Lebanon Township, North Lebanon Township, Jonestown Borough, North Cornwall Township, North Londonderry Township, and Cornwall Borough were presented with a Municipal Recycling Award recognizing each municipality for outstanding recycling achievements in 2021.

The six municipalities in Lebanon County honored for their exemplary recycling efforts...

- West Lebanon Township has the highest municipal recycling rate of 78%
- North Lebanon Township has a municipal recycling rate of 72%
- Jonestown Borough has a municipal recycling rate of 54%
- North Cornwall Township has a municipal recycling rate of 52%
- North Londonderry Township has a municipal recycling rate of 51%
- Cornwall Borough has the most improved municipal recycling rate up from 27% in 2020 to 34% in 2021
