All leaves shall be placed to the **REAR** of the property, not in streets or alleys, **NO LESS** than 2 Feet from the alley. **NO BAGS, DO NOT** place sticks, twigs or other yard debris in the leaf piles as this causes damage to our equipment. **Weather permitting, pick up will start at 8:00 am.**

Please remove all decorations from the tree, **DO NOT** put the tree in a bag for pick up. **DO NOT** put trees out for trash pick up. **Weather permitting, pick up will start at 8:00am.**

Recycling News in West Lebanon Township

West Lebanon is mandated under ACT 101 to recycle.
Every resident and businesses must recycle, per ordinance #417.

Items **TO BE** recycled:

Cans ~ Aluminum, steel & metallic cans.

Glass ~ Bottles & jars: clear, brown and green.

Plastic ~ Bottles and jugs. An easy way to identify what goes in the recycling bin is to check the neck, a bottle or jar with an opening that is smaller than the base, or widest, part is acceptable. Please wash out any food residue.

Newspapers ~ must be tied in a bundle or in a paper bag.

Corrugated Cardboard ~ dry and flattened

Items **NOT TO BE** recycled:

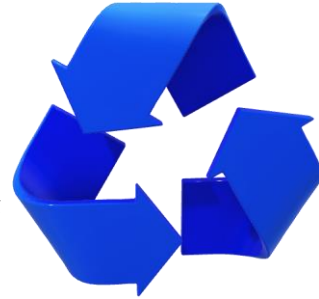
margarine, yogurt tubs, deli food containers, flowerpots, food storage or microwave containers, glasses or vases, lightbulbs, styrofoam, plastic bags and/or shredded paper.

The **GREEN RECYCLING** can is for recycling items only. The trash hauler will not pick up any trash that is in the green recycling can. Every Commercial Business in West Lebanon Township **MUST** recycle **ALL** corrugated cardboard, all grades of office papers, mixed paper, aluminum cans and all green waste.

ELECTRONIC RECYCLING of TV's, computers, cell phones, printers, etc., is available for FREE to Lebanon County residents at the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority. Please visit their website for more information. www.goglra.org

GREEN WASTE DROP off SITE is located at the 2100 block of Lehman Street behind the Recreation Area. This is for Township residents and businesses to drop yard waste, grass, leaves and brush/branches.

Please put items in their designated area. No items should be in bags or boxes. Tree stumps, construction waste or pressure treated lumber is **NOT** acceptable. Applications for a Green Waste gate key card is available online or at the office. Cost is \$30.00.





MS-4 Regulations are as follows:
Only **Rain** should go down the drain. **NO** discharging pool water on to the streets, **NO** grass, cigarette butts, water bottles, or other debris should be deposited on to the streets. **NO** washing or

working/repairing on vehicles on the street is prohibited. If violations, fines will be issued. See the Township web site for more information

Winter weather is on the way!!

During bad weather stay tuned to the local media for any snow emergencies and a listing of snow emergency routes for plowing the streets.

Please clear the snow from the sidewalks within 24 hours of the snow fall. **DO NOT SHOVEL SNOW INTO THE STREET!**

Plows will be on the streets during and after heavy snowfall.

- 1) Layer up! By layering up you will be able to withstand the cold weather.
- 2) Check on neighbors! Unfortunately, with the winter weather comes shoveling and cleaning off your vehicles. If you have a neighbor that is elderly or disabled in any way, please check on them. Be kind, checking on neighbors only takes a few minutes of your time.
- 3) Take breaks! Don't try to shovel all at once. You'll only tire yourself out and move slower.
- 4) What needs to be removed from the right of way during a snow event are as follows; any **SPORTS EQUIPMENT** (net, hoop and backboards). Any damage inflicted by Township vehicles will be the responsibility of the property owner. Any damage caused to Township equipment is

also the responsibility of the property owner. **VEHICLES** must be removed from **SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES** before snow starts falling.

- 5) Low hanging wires and overgrown shrubs are the responsibility of the property owner to be properly trimmed. Heavy snow and ice can cause wires and shrubs to become heavy and hang low. If the property owner does not trim trees and plants (up to 14 feet from the curb and street) the Township is allowed by state law to trim trees to provide the safety of the motoring public, **at the owners' expense.**
- 6) Windy days mean trash cans and refuse blowing around the Township causing a hazard. All trash must be kept in a leak proof garbage container with a proper fitting lid. It is the responsibility of the owner and/or lessee of the property to keep all garbage, refuse, and/or other materials within the receptacle at all times. It is also your responsibility to **IMMEDIATELY** clean up any garbage, refuse, or other items that have blown or spilled outside of their containers. All residents and/or property owners in West Lebanon Township must use **T-N-T Sanitation** (717-866-2322) for all trash and recycling services as they are West Lebanon's contracted hauler.
