

WEST LEBANON TOWNSHIP
July 9, 2024

The Special Meeting of the West Lebanon Township Board of Commissioners was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President John Gurganus with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Josh Weaber started the meeting by explaining the two different options for 25th Street. Ideally one of these should be done by 7/29/24 when paving is scheduled to begin. The new option would be to move the storm sewer to the shoulder of the road. The problem with this option is the unknowns such as hitting rock, timing for the catch basins, utility crossings, and future deterioration of the abandoned pipe, which would slow everything down. The replacement option is just replacing the existing pipe. The contractor could still run into the rock or more sink holes, but they know most of what needs to be done.

Discussion was held to try and decide the best option.

Julie Clouse asked when the work could be started. Josh Weaber stated work can be started as early as the week of July 15, 2024.

Phylis Dryden made a motion seconded by Justin Snyder and agreed by the board to accept the proposal for the emergency repairs, of replacement of storm sewer pipe along 25th Street for a project cost of \$59,279.00 by Bechtold Excavating. The emergency repairs along 25th Street is due to the formation of a sinkhole which must be replaced immediately. All in favor.

Justin Snyder made a motion, seconded by Phylis Dryden and agreed by the board to accept the proposal for emergency repairs on 24th Street between Lehman Street and Church Street for Bechtold to replace a portion of the storm sewer pipe and for lining of the storm sewer pipe to be completed by Mr. Rehab for an estimated cost of \$97,387.75. The emergency repairs along 24th Street between Church Street and Lehman is due to the formation of a sinkhole which must be replaced immediately. All in favor.

The next meeting of the West Lebanon Township Board of Commissioners is Monday, August 5, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. at the West Lebanon Township Building, 322 North 22nd Street.

Joe Templin made a motion, seconded by Justin Snyder and agreed by the Board to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 p.m.
